Directions to Workshop

From Houston:

- Begin on I10 East
- Take FM 3180 exit and go north over I10 for 2 miles
- Turn right (East) on to FM 565 at light (Valero station)
- Go 3 miles and turn Left on to FM 1409 at light
- Continue North on FM 1409 for 2 miles.
- Pass the Philips 66 on the right. The house is the second the left after the station.
- The house has a metal roof and 3 car garage

From Beaumont:

- Begin on I10 West
- Exit FM 565 and turn right on to FM 565
- Go north on FM 565 to the stop light at FM 1409
- Turn right (North) on to FM 1409 and continue for 2 miles.
- Pass the Philips 66 on the right. The house is the second on the left after the station.
- The house has a metal roof and 3 car garage
